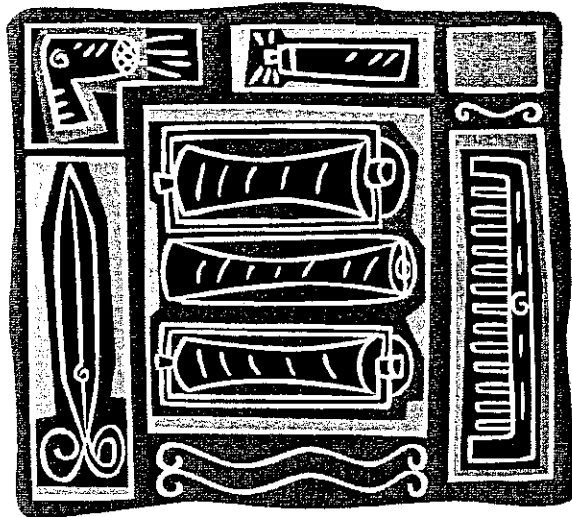

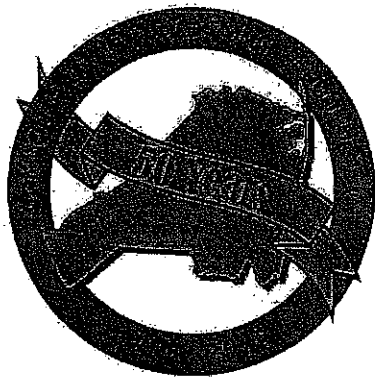

ADMISSION PROCEDURES

1. Qualified pupils should be entering the eleventh or twelfth grade.
2. To obtain an application, please see your school counselor or visit http://www.mcvsd.org/st/MCVSD_Shared_Time/Admissions.html
3. Complete the required application. Bring the application to your school so that the school portion can be completed and signed by a school official. Support materials **must** be included (i.e., grade transcript).
4. **Application deadline is March 30, 2012.**

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. What must be included with my application?

A. The application must be completely filled out and signed by parent/guardian and school official with grade transcripts from the first marking period of grade 9 through the second marking period of grade 10. The school must also send a copy of any NJ State Testing results, Child Study Team reports and IEP information (if applicable). The deadline for applications is March 30, 2012.

Q. What are the criteria for acceptance into the regular shared time programs?

A. Students must have an expressed interest in the occupational area they are applying to. Students must also have an excellent attendance record (less than fifteen days absent per year) and have a minimum grade point average of "C". Students and parent(s) must tour the program prior to submitting an application.

Q. What are the criteria for acceptance into the tech prep shared time programs?

A. Applicants for tech prep programs must meet all of the above criteria. In addition, students must have successfully completed (grade "C" or better) Algebra and one year of science. Students interested in Allied Health must have successfully completed laboratory biology.

Q. What are the requirements for the Health Science programs?

A. Students participating in a Health Science Program **MUST** receive medical clearances from personal physicians/clinics prior to entering the program. Students need proper documentation such as a current address and social security number in order to obtain a certification from the State Board of Nursing.

Q. What are the requirements for the cosmetology program?

A. All high school 10th and 11th grade students interested in applying for the MCVSD Cosmetology Program must take and pass the Cosmetology Entrance Exam on March 24, 2012. This 3-part exam covers: Practical dexterity, Reading Comprehension and basic Mathematical Computation.

Q. Are there waiting lists?

A. Qualified students who apply by the application deadline will be given priority. Other qualified students may be accepted based upon program vacancies and the individual merits and needs of the applicant.

Q. How do I determine if I have an interest in an occupational area?

A. Students and parent(s) or legal guardian(s) must tour the program prior to submitting an application. This may be accomplished through attendance at an information session, open house, orientation, teacher interview, tour with a MCVSD counselor, or other means arranged with the Principal.

Q. What is tech prep?

A. Tech-Prep 2+2 provides a strong integration of academics with vocational skills training. In Tech-Prep programs an articulation agreement has been established between the MCVSD and post secondary institutions (2 & 4 year colleges, trade and technical institutes). Credit is earned upon successful completion of the vocational/technical program and requirements established between MCVSD & participating higher educational partners. Students may continue the college/technical program until they earn an Associates or Bachelors Degree or Industry Standards Certificates.

Q. What is Career Technical Education Math?

A. **Career Technical Education Math (CTEM)** is a combination of algebra, geometry and numerical concepts. Curricula is devoted to enhancing the student's mathematical understanding within the vocational/technical area as well as assist in preparation to successfully meet the New Jersey High School Proficiency Assessment (HSPA) requirement and basic skills college entrance exam (ACCUPLACER & TERRA NOVA).

Q. What is Career Technical Education Science?

A. **Career Technical Education Science (CTES)** is a combination of physical science, environmental science and various concepts of general science. Curricula is devoted to enhancing the student's understanding and relationship of science within the vocational/technical area as well as assist in preparation to successfully meet the proposed New Jersey High School graduation requirement.

Q. What is Integrated Career Technical Education Math and Science?

A. **Integrated CTE Math (ICTEM)** consists of topics from a wide variety of mathematical fields such as algebra, geometry, trigonometry, probability and statistics. **Integrated CTE Science (ICTES)** emphasizes the relationships amongst science concepts such as biology, chemistry, physics, environmental and social science.

Q. Are there any information sessions or open houses scheduled?

A. Yes. An information session is scheduled for January 7, 2012 at High Technology High School located on the Brookdale Community College campus (make up date due to inclement weather is January 14, 2012). Each vocational building will host an open house on February 23, 2012.

Q. How and when will I be notified of acceptance?

A. It will take approximately four weeks for all processing to be completed after the application deadline. All applicants who have submitted a completed application with all the required materials by the application deadline will be notified by mail whether they have been accepted or not.

Q. How will I make arrangements for transportation if I attend a Vocational School?

A. The Monmouth County Vocational School District is a public school district. If you have been accepted, your resident school district will be notified. Transportation is the responsibility of the resident district.
