


GET HELP WITH AFFORDING HEALTH CARE COVERAGE



If you are uninsured, including if you recently lost your job-based health coverage, you may qualify for low-cost or free coverage through NJ FamilyCare.



It covers doctor's visits, hospitalizations, prescriptions, mental health services, vaccines and more.



NJ FamilyCare is comprehensive, affordable health insurance for individuals earning up to \$1,468 per month or a family of four earning up to \$3,013 per month.



Enrollment is open year-round and NJ FamilyCare is here to help, especially in tough times like these when more people need access to coverage and care.

*The additional \$600 in weekly UI benefits as well as stimulus checks being provided amid COVID-19 will not count as income for NJ FamilyCare eligibility.

NJ FamilyCare has made some important changes to better serve you during the current COVID-19 public health emergency. Here's what you need to know:

- You will not be disenrolled from NJ FamilyCare during the public health emergency.
- There will be no NJ FamilyCare or CHIP premiums during the public health emergency.
- COVID-19 testing and treatment is covered, at no cost to you.
- We are making it as easy as possible for you to get health care – including expanding telehealth so that you can connect with your health care provider via phone or video, making it easier to get prescriptions refilled early and for extended time, and many other steps.
