Content: Random Drug Testing Program

Dear Parent/Guardian,

At the June 23, 2005 board meeting, the Shore Regional High School Board of Education passed a resolution to institute Random Drug Testing in September of 2005.

The goal of the program is to:

- Provide a safe and drug free environment
- Be a tool for intervention and treatment
- Teach refusal skills
- Act as a deterrent

The Program is non-punitive and seeks to work cooperatively with the parent(s) or guardian(s) in sending our students a strong message against drug use. This program will allow us another opportunity to identify and help those students who are involved with alcohol, steroids, and illegal drugs. It is a proactive approach aimed at prevention, identification, and intervention of substance abuse.

Random drug testing effects the following students:

- Anyone participating on an athletic team
- Anyone who is a member of an extracurricular activity, including all clubs and organizations.
- Any student issued a parking permit

Students will be given the appropriate forms from their advisors, coaches, or the Assistant Principal, Mr. Peter Bruccoleri. The forms must be completed prior to participation in the activity.
