Parents/Guardians and Students: Please read the following contract thoroughly before signing each page.

***** Please read, sign, and submit these forms to Mr. Bruccoleri's Office no later than Friday, May 25, 2018.*****

The prom is a special event, and students' attendance at this event is a privilege that is subject to compliance with the rules and other provisions set forth in this contract as well as all school rules and Board Policies. Violations of this contract or school policies will result in disciplinary action and possible police notification. Furthermore, any violation of the Shore Regional High School District Substance Abuse Policy by any student may also result in loss of the privilege to participate in any extra-curricular activities, athletic events and graduation.

- Students and guests may start arriving at 7:00 p.m. **All students must arrive at the prom by 8:00 p.m.** Any student arriving later than this time will not be admitted to the prom and a parent/guardian will be contacted. Students must remain at the prom until 10:00 p.m.
- Students must fulfill all outstanding disciplinary actions in order to be eligible to attend the senior prom. No refund will be given to students who do not meet this requirement.
- All students attending the prom must remain in school on the date of the prom until the end of Block 2 (7:30 a.m. - 10:30 a.m.).
- Parents/Guardians and students **must** attend the Mission Prom program in order to be eligible to attend the senior prom. No refund will be issued to a student who is deemed ineligible to attend the prom for failure to attend the Mission Prom program.
- Once inside the venue, no student may leave the building. No one will be permitted to go to a car.
- No smoking is permitted inside or outside the facility at any time.
- No backpacks, bags, or storage containers other than small purses will be permitted into the prom. Purses are subject to search at any time.
- Students may not switch or substitute a guest the day of the prom. No refund will be given if a student or his/her guest is unable to attend for any reason.
- All guests must be under the age of 21 years old. (See administration for any questions.)

Attire - Formal attire is required. Students and guests are expected to dress in an appropriate manner. Any student or guest not dressed appropriately will be required to leave the prom, and a parent/guardian will be notified. No refund will be given.

Substance Abuse Policies and Procedures for Proms

The following procedures will be carried out for any student or guest suspected of possession or use of alcohol or a controlled dangerous substance.

1. Students and guests, upon arrival, will be breathalyzed by a trained professional. Any student or guest who refuses, will not be admitted in to the prom. Parent/Guardian will be notified.
2. If a student or guest does not pass the breathalyzer or is confirmed to be Under the Influence of alcohol or a Controlled Dangerous Substance, law enforcement and a parent/guardian may be notified, and the parent/guardian will be required to pick up his/her child.
3. The student/guest may be subject to police action, including arrest or other legal charges.
4. All consequences outlined in the Student Handbook and Board Policy will be enforced, including suspension, loss of parking privileges, loss of privileges to participate in extra-curricular activities and sports, and any other applicable penalties.

A CONFIRMED POSITIVE DRUG/ALCOHOL TEST OR CONFIRMED POSSESSION OF ALCOHOL, DRUGS OR DRUG PARAPHERNALIA MAY RESULT IN:

A. LOSS OF THE PRIVILEGE FOR SENIORS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE GRADUATION CEREMONY.

B. ADDITIONAL DISCIPLINARY ACTION DEEMED APPROPRIATE BY ADMINISTRATION

Students and their guests are expected to act in a mature and appropriate manner at the prom. The prom facility is considered an extension of the school; therefore, all school rules and Board Policies, including disciplinary actions, will be in effect. The parent/guardian will be notified if a student disregards the rules and policies, and the student or guest may be removed from the prom with no refund.

Any student bringing a guest who is not a student of Shore Regional High School will be responsible for his/her guest adhering to this contract as well as all school rules and Board policies. Also, the guest must complete an Outside Guest Permission Slip, which is located in the Assistant Principal's Office or see your class advisor for a copy.

Any student found falsifying any information, signature, or initials on this contract will not be permitted to attend the prom, no refund will be given, and disciplinary action will be taken.

Compliance with the rules set forth in this contract as well a school rules and Board Policies is a condition of admittance to and continued attendance at the prom. Violations of this contract, school rules, or Board Policies will result in disciplinary action, removal from the prom, and parent/guardian notification. Violation of the Board's Substance Abuse Policy may result in police notification and loss of certain privileges, including, but not limited to the privilege to participate in this year's graduation ceremony. Administrative discretion will be used in the final adjudication of all penalties and disciplinary actions.
