*the acronym IBO refers to “International Baccalaureate Organization”



When do IB exams happen?

- All exams take place in May 2022; the schedule is [here](#).
- Please be aware of potential conflicts between exams and Spring Athletic events.
- Please note, each subject area exam is referred to as ‘Papers.’ There are *usually* 2 parts: Paper 1, Paper 2.
- *The exception:* HL history, here students will take (write) 3 history ‘papers’ that are combined, with their internal assessment, for their overall subject score.



How does my student register for IB exams?

- ▣ Students register via this [Google Form](#) and bring their payment (by check) to Mrs. Miano in Room E-15 or leave in her Main Office mailbox.
- ▣ Mrs. Miano will be visiting all Senior IB classes over the next week to answer questions about the registration process.



How do I pay for the exam fees?

- ❑ The IBO charges a fee of \$119 for each exam/course assessment.
This includes the Arts, even though written exams are not given in some subjects.
- ❑ To pay the IB exam fees, please write a check out to Shore Regional High School with the phrase “IB Testing Fees” in the Memo.
- ❑ **Please note**, if any changes are made to registrations after the due date, additional fees are charged by the IBO. This also includes charges for late registrations.
- ❑ **Payment is due by Friday, November 8, 2021.**
- ❑ Please see Mrs. Miano if more time is needed to pay for exams; we can set up a payment schedule.



What are student responsibilities in this process?

- ▣ Share exams choices with parents/guardians.
- ▣ Complete IB Exam Registration Google Form with parents/guardians
- ▣ Discuss the exam schedule with parents/guardians and do not make plans during the exam period. There is no set make-up exam period. Excused absences are examined by the IBO on a case-by-case basis.
- ▣ Prepare for exams by asking questions, participating actively in your class discussions, assignments, mock examination practice.



What are guardian/parent responsibilities?

- ❑ Complete IB Exam Registration Google Form with student.
- ❑ Pay for exams.
- ❑ Discuss exam schedule with student (be aware of potential conflicts now).
- ❑ Support student in preparing for exams.
