

Policy

INSURANCE

The Shore Regional High School Board of Education shall provide accident insurance covering all students for medical costs incurred as a result of a school time injury, or an injury received during any school-sponsored or school-related activity, excluding interscholastic sports. This coverage is excess, and is payable after payment or consideration from a family health insurance plan. If a parent does not have insurance, then the board accident insurance policy shall become the primary coverage for an accident.

Every parent/guardian shall be given the opportunity at the beginning of the school year to purchase accident insurance for their children. Each student will be given literature and an application form in September of each year.

New Jersey Family Care

The school nurse shall ensure that the parent/guardians of students who are without medical coverage are notified of and provided information on the accessibility of the New Jersey Family Care Program in accordance with N.J.S.A. 18A:40-34.
