GUIDELINES FOR SHORE PLAYERS AND OTHER DRAMATIC PRODUCTIONS

The following procedures shall apply to participation in the dramatic productions of the Shore Players:

- A. The Shore Players and the Drama Club will be composed completely of current student body members;
- B. All roles will be given to currently enrolled students of Shore Regional High School on the basis of ability and talent. In cases wherein ability and talent are equal, in the judgment of the production director, upper class students shall be given preference and/or consideration;
- C. Roles requiring very small children may be given to students in the elementary school grades only if these parts are minor and there are no students of high school age who could realistically portray these roles;
- D. All expenditures for the production of any dramatic or musical event and all revenues derived from admission charges for any dramatic or musical event will be controlled by the regular school account;
- E. Parents who associate for the purpose of encouraging, assisting and supporting the Shore Players must understand that the activity is under the jurisdiction of the board of education, which recognizes Shore Players as an extracurricular school activity;
- F. The production director of musical and/or dramatic plays is appointed by the board upon recommendation of the school administration;
- G. The production director of musical and/or dramatic plays will recommend the title of such productions to the school administration for approval;
- H. The superintendent will recommend the title of musical and/or dramatic plays for approval by the board of education;
- I. In order to provide a reasonable time framework for preparing the various play productions during the school year, and not to burden students for excessive periods of time and to allow students to make choices for other cocurricular activities, the following time schedules for dramatic productions should be followed:

Fall	September 15 to December 15	Musical/nonmusical drama
Winter	December 16 to March 31	Musical dramas

- J. Upon completion of the production, a financial report will be submitted to the school business administrator.
