- In the event that you have any questions or concerns regarding your child’s schedule, please contact your counselor via e-mail. Please do not call the counseling office; **counselors will attend to conflicts in the order that they received (via e-mail)** and make every effort to accommodate requests.

- **Locker assignments** - for all grade levels will appear on the individual student schedules. For security reasons, do not change lockers or share combinations
