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Contents: ABOUT THE A/B BLOCK

For the last several years, the Shore Regional High School faculty committees, administrative team members, and monthly Principal's Parent Forum attendees have been discussing/exploring options to our academic format in search of a schedule that more closely mirrored a collegiate structure.

With the overwhelming majority of our students attending college after high school, the primary focus for migrating to a block schedule is to prepare them for this experience. The (alternating day) A/B block schedule will allow students the most academic flexibility while maximizing their educational opportunities.

In addition to this schedule change, we have incorporated an “Academic Support Period” into each school day which will allow for students to meet with teachers in an academic study period. This period is required for academic support/homework/projects etc. for all students grade 9-11. “ASP” will also serve as an opportunity for support services. All grade 12 students will be permitted to leave at the conclusion of the 4th block.

The block schedule will provide the opportunity for students to take up to 40 credits each year of their career at SRHS. It will also provide more time-on-task as they prepare for a future on the collegiate level. In addition, we believe it will assist in better preparing students for recent changes to state assessments and SAT's.

We look forward to taking on this exciting endeavor collaboratively with the faculty, parents, and students of the Shore Regional Community.
